Feng Shui Tip: Use Your Front Door

I chose this Irish toast for the March newsletter not just because of St. Patrick's Day, but because it shows how universal Feng Shui advice can be: a smooth path to your front door represents the flow of prosperity and happiness into your life. We call the front door the mouth of chi because it typically faces the street, which symbolizes a gentle river flowing into a home. Rivers are associated with prosperity and the front door is the conduit for bringing that prosperity into your house. Therefore, when you use your front door, even if only to pick up the newspaper, get the mail, or let in some sunshine, you create an opportunity for wealth to enter. Here is my Feng Shui challenge for March: Open your front door every day. And if you usually enter your home through the garage or back door, for the next seven days use only the front door of your home and notice the new opportunities that flow into your life.

Clutter Clinic: Green Spring Cleaning

Spring is just around the corner and Spring cleaning is always a good Feng Shui idea. But ironically many products that make a home clean can make the environment dirty. Here are some tips from the nonprofit organizations EarthShare (www.EarthShare.org) and EarthWays (www.EarthWays.org) for making your own green cleaning products:

• Countertops and walls: Make a mixture of warm water, dish soap, and baking soda.

- Carpet freshener: Sprinkle dry cornstarch or baking soda on your carpet and vacuum.
- **Rug stains:** Blot stains with a mixture of vinegar and soapy water.
- Mildew: Make a paste of vinegar and salt and apply to the area.
- **Furniture polish:** Combine 1/2 cup lemon juice and 1 cup of vegetable oil, olive oil, or mayonnaise.
- **Drain Cleaner:** Pour 1/2 cup of baking soda down the sink and add 1 cup of vinegar. Cover the drain and wait a few minutes, then rinse with a mixture of boiling water and salt.
- Window Cleaner: Mix 2 ounces of vinegar with 1 quart of water in a spray bottle.
- Silver Polish: Put a sheet of aluminum foil into a plastic or glass bowl. Sprinkle the foil with salt and baking soda and fill the bowl with warm water, and soak your silver.

Success Story: Kelley's Harmonious House

I received this update from Kelley a month after her consultation: We have done a lot to make our home more harmonious since your visit and the results are already obvious, even though we are still a work in progress. We painted the garage door entry into our home with the same color as our front door and hung two art posters on the garage walls. These changes have warmed up our garage immensely and now I always have a smile on my face when I get out of my car. Most important, we took the exercise cycle out of the bedroom and with it went a lot of guilt about not using it. I framed a postcard I purchased on our European trip and placed it on my night table. It is the first thing I see in the morning and the last when I go to bed at night, reminding me of how romantic we were on that vacation. We repainted our too hot orange bedroom in a skin tone shade. As you predicted, our relationship has improved with the cooler color on the walls. Now, even if we do have a disagreement, al least it is not a heated debate. And we have those a lot less often.

Feng Shui Q & A

Q: Which of the Five Elements includes plastics?

A: While the color of a plastic object does represent one of the Five Elements, the material itself does not have life and is not really an element. If you have lots of items surrounding you that are plastic, they are not attracting the flow of positive chi. Replace as many as you can with objects made of natural materials. For example, replace the plastic accessories on your desk with wood, glass, or metal; exchange the plastic trashcan for a wicker or metal one; choose ceramic or metal containers for your plants.

Q: In going through a trunk in my attic, I found a box of old letters from friends. I have been reading the letters and realized that I have let wonderful friendships fall by the wayside. Though the letters do not say anything important, it made me realize how much I have changed, for the better and the worse in some cases. Should I throw away the letters or keep them?

A: Get rid of the letters because they represent old, stale energy. Instead of obsessing about ways you think you have changed for the worse, just learn from the wisdom that finding the letters has provided you. Call, write, or e-mail the friends you want to reconnect with and tell them exactly what happened, that you found old letters and they made you realize how much you missed their friendship.
