Feng Shui Tip: Feng Shui and Weight Loss

If you made a New Year's resolution to lose weight this year, you are not alone, it is one of the top 10 resolutions. Here are a few Feng Shui tips to help you succeed:

- To slow down your eating, switch to blue plates. Blue is the color of the Water Element that can relax and slow down the body by reducing blood pressure and pulse.
- If your kitchen is in a direct line with your front door, or if it is the first room you see when you enter the house, it may encourage eating. Keep the kitchen door closed or hang a mirror or artwork near the door to distract your eye away from the room.
- The color red stimulates the appetite, so avoid using a red tablecloth or placemats. Instead, choose blue, black, or floral patterns for your table coverings.
- A cluttered kitchen can psychologically add weight. Clear the clutter from your pantry, cabinets, drawers, counters and refrigerator to *lighten* your kitchen and, consequently, your weight.
- If you hold on to clothes that do not fit, it symbolizes holding on to old behavior patterns. Get rid of the clothes you can't wear and you will make room for new clothes--in smaller sizes--to flow into the space you open up in your closets.

Clutter Clinic: Recycling Gift Cards

Feng Shui supports the concept of re-gifting. When you donate or sell those holiday gifts that you do not like, you remove clutter and put these objects into the hands of people who are grateful to have them. But what about those gift cards from stores you never shop at? Unused gift cards represent mental clutter. Clear the clutter by cashing in unwanted gift cards at sites such as www.swapagift.com. For a small fee you can exchange, sell, or buy gift cards, which is better than letting them expire. Another site, www.zunafish.com, allows you to swap CDs, DVDs and video games at \$1 per trade plus postage. A small price to pay for an uncluttered mind.

Success Story: Carol's Red Folders

This success story is my own. When I start working with a new client, I always create a <u>red</u> folder, because I want to use the powerful attributes of the Fire Element to improve the client's life. Since I have offices in two different regions of the country, I had been buying boxes of 500 folders at one location and moving half of them to the other. Recently I had a *V-8 Moment* (*see below for more about these moments*). I realized that by splitting the box of folders, I was splitting my business. I immediately bought full boxes of folders for each office. The result was a powerful **doubling** of requests for consultations in both areas! Think about your own business, career, or life. Is there anything you are doing that is dividing or splitting your wealth?

Q: I heard about a *New York Times* article that said clutter and messiness are good. What do you think?

A: According to the article, *Say Yes to Mess*, an anti-clutter clearing movement is urging people to embrace disorder. The article cites studies showing that people with messy desks earn higher salaries than those with neat offices, and that people with messy closets may be better parents than their tidier counterparts. In Feng Shui, clutter represents postponed decisions and the inability to move forward. Clutter is the number one problem for the hundreds of clients I have worked with, and when they clear their clutter, amazing improvements flow into the open spaces in their lives. You be the judge: clear the clutter out of your life and see what flows in to take its place. Read the *Times* article then let me know what you think.

Q: I live in a small condo and the only choices for places to keep my cat's litter box are in my kitchen or in my office; I chose the office. I looked at the bagua chart on your website and it seems like the box is in the wealth area. Is there anything I can do to keep both my cat and my wealth?

A: The ideal place for a litter box is in the basement, garage, or bathroom. While keeping a litter box in an office does not encourage wealth, it is certainly better than keeping it in the kitchen if you have no other choice. Kitchens are associated with food and the negative chi of the litter box is detrimental to your health. I recommend you buy a covered litter box so you do not see "waste" every time you enter the office. Whatever kind of box you use, be sure you empty the box often and keep it as clean as possible.

Q: Are peacock feathers auspicious? I have heard both for and against having these inside the home.

A: Some schools of Feng Shui feel that peacock feathers are auspicious because they signify beauty and dignity, and recommend placing the feathers at the front door because the "eye" can drive evil

spirits away. As with any object, my main concern would be your feelings toward the feathers. If you like peacock feathers and you have a positive reaction to them, display them in your home. If you have any negative associations to them or feel ambivalent about them, out they go!

Q&A Follow-up:

Here is a follow-up to a question I ran in last month's newsletter from a reader who had a storm drain in front of her house and thought that symbolically it might be "draining" the wealth from her home. Since water represents the flow of wealth, one of my recommendations was for her to add actual water or positive images of water in her foyer. This is the follow-up I received:

I have been thinking about your cure and just realized that I have a piece of art in the foyer that has 4 snowflakes--frozen water! Yikes! I'm going to move it to another location to get my money/prosperity thawed and moving again. Even the frame is frozen, an icy blue metal frame. Results to follow.

That is my job...to get my clients and readers thinking! I call it the *V-8 Moment*. Remember those commercials for V-8 juice where people slapped their foreheads when they remembered they could have had a V-8 instead of some other snack that was not as healthy? That is the symbolic reaction I want to see when people suddenly look at something in a new light after I open their *Feng Shui Eyes*.
