Feng Shui Tip For October: Halloween Feng Shui

By popular request, here are some Halloween Feng Shui decorating tips:



Use the Colors Orange and Black. It's natural to use lots of the orange and black in Halloween decorations, and it's also good Feng Shui because of what these colors represent. Orange is a Fire Element and the "social color" that promotes excitement and encourages conversation and communication, which

is especially important to assure a lively and festive Halloween. Black is the Water Element color that represents the flow on energy. When used by your front door it will help "call" the good energy --and lot of trick or treaters -- to your home.

Hang Cobwebs. Halloween is the one time that cobwebs are considered positive Feng Shui because they help create atmosphere. Normally, cobwebs around your front door or outdoor furniture represent being so stuck that you are unable to move forward. Just be sure to quickly remove all webs from around the outside and inside of your home after Halloween, and sweep away the real cobwebs while you're at it.

Use Animal Symbols. Owls, bats, and ravens are obvious Halloween Feng Shui symbols. Outdoors, display owls and bats by your front door and inside place them in windows ominously peering out. Ravens are a powerful Halloween Feng Shui symbol because their deep black color represents mystery.

Clear Clutter. As with all Feng Shui advice, Halloween will be more fun if you thoroughly clear the clutter before you decorate to remove negative energy and renew your home for the season. And a few days after Halloween be sure to clear all the candy clutter from your house after your children pick out their favorites.

Handling Magazine and Newspaper Clutter



Here is a clutter-clearing project you can tackle this weekend: organizing your magazines, newspapers, and holiday catalogs.

- 1. Go through all your rooms (don't forget the bathroom) and gather your newspapers, magazines, and catalogs, then place them in piles on the kitchen or dining room table.
- 2. Go through your piles and if a newspaper is more than a day old, toss it into the recycling bin.
- 3. If you have any magazines or catalogs that you know you will never read, toss them in the recycling; consider canceling your subscription to magazines you aren't interested in anymore or you can read online.
- 4. If you have flagged magazine articles or catalog pages, tear out those pages and scan them so you have an electronic version, then add the pages and the entire issue to the recycling bin.
- 5. For magazines and catalogs you still want to read, write today's date on the cover and place them in your "reading area;" if you haven't read them in a month, recycle immediately.


Ask the Feng Shui Maven

Q: I am trying to sell a house that has a light green bedroom. Several potential buyers have commented that the color is uncomfortable for them. What color should I repaint it?

A: Green is the color of the Wood Element, which represents growth and expansion, and it is too stimulating for a bedroom. The ideal color for a bedroom is a "skin tone," ranging from ivory to mahogany. So you can see why a light green doesn't feel right to buyers. However, if your buyers see a room in a color such as blush, rose, or peach, they will feel more comfortable in the room. And you will sleep better in the room knowing that you have taken a step toward attracting a buyer for your house.

Q: Is it bad Feng Shui to buy cast-offs and other second hand items from a consignment store? My budget is strained these days so I'm trying to save money where I can.

A: The key word in your question is "cast-offs." If you have negative feelings about anything you buy, no matter what kind of store it comes from, you will bring that negative energy into your home. Buying second-hand can be positive Feng Shui as long as you feel good about the object you are acquiring. It will be negative Feng Shui if you feel you are accepting second best because it's all you can afford. The one exception is bedding, where new is always better for something you sleep on every night.


